

The Experiential Learning Center is committed to developing quality internships and co-ops that provide real-world professional experiences for UCD students. “Recent Internships and Co-ops” provides an overview of the jobs students do when they participate in internships and co-ops. Students are given the option of participating in a site visit and having their internship or co-op profiled on our website.

During a site visit, ELC Internship and Co-op Advisors will meet mentors, take a few pictures of where the student works and tour the facility. The visit usually takes a maximum of an hour and provides the opportunity to see, first hand, where the student works and what they get to do. Site visits are generally conducted for new internship and co-op sites, to ensure the student’s welfare, and to provide a face to the support that is in place for both students and employers.

“Featured Interns & Co-ops” and “Featured Employers” provide a number of long-term added benefits to both the student and employer by:

- adding to the marketability of both the intern and the organization
- enabling future employers to conduct positive Google searches on the intern
- providing the intern a website for referring future employers
- encouraging other potential interns to apply for internships at the profiled organization
- enabling featured organizations the opportunity to choose from UCD’s best candidates
